






Assembly Instructions




1. Get ready to prime the system.
Fill the base unit clean water tank with warm-to-the-touch tap water to the fill line.




2. Before connecting the bathing tool, place the unit on a high, flat surface and extend the hose to a microfiber mat or towel on floor.




3. Turn machine ON and press the flex hose trigger for 15-20 seconds to allow water to dispense on a microfiber mat or towel.




4. Locate the bathing tool and twist cap on the shampoo tank counter-clockwise to open.




5. Hold tool right side up and add BISSELL No-Rinse Dog Shampoo to the shampoo reservoir.




6. Align screw cap with tabs of reservoir opening and twist shut.



7. Hold the tool horizontally on a flat surface (such as table or counter top) and attach it to the cleaner by inserting the flex hose connector into the shampoo tool connector. You will hear a “click” when it locks in place.



8. Set Rinse/Shampoo switch to desired setting. For Shampoo, the reservoir will dispense a mixture of shampoo and water; for Rinse, it will dispense just water.



9. With the base unit and reservoir on a table, extend the hose and nozzle to the mat or towel on floor and spray trigger for 15-20 seconds until solution dispenses.



IMPORTANT FAQs



No water is coming from the BarkBath™ tool?

Be sure to prime the BarkBath unit and tool for first use by following the priming instructions in the use and care guide (a video on priming is also available on BISSELL.com).



Brush your dog first.

To assure the spray nozzle can go through your dog's fur, brush your dog first before using the BarkBath™. This will detangle the dog's fur and allow the nozzle to easily penetrate the fur.



Upon completion of the bath, water will remain in the hose.

When done bathing, disconnect the BarkBath™ tool. Hold the hose in the air and nozzle in the sink, pressing the trigger to assure all water empties from the hose.



Noise – some dogs don't like the sound.
